## Standard

- CMU Faculty will use Standard Grading for Certificate Learning Offerings.
- Standard Grading assesses a learner based on the accuracy of their responses to assessments within the course.
- Learners will earn credit based on their answers to the assessment questions.

## Participation

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- CMU Faculty will use Participation Grading for Participation Learning Offerings.
- Participation grading tracks a learner's progress as they interact with each of the elements in a course, whether they are content or assessments.
- As the learner opens each element and navigates through them, they will earn participation progress until they have completed 100% of the elements in the course.
- For assessments, learners are not graded on accuracy- they will earn participation credit for each question they answer, whether their answer is correct or incorrect.
